

# Rules and Conditions of Entry

**Entry Fees :**     **£6.00 if pre-entered**  
                          **£8.00 if entered on the day**  
                          **(unless otherwise stated in the schedule)**  
                          **(+ £1.00 per competitor for first aid cover)**

1. The Organisers and Landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any accident or injury to owners, riders, spectators, horse, pony or any other person, property or vehicle whatsoever or howsoever caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Organisers and Landowners against any legal action from any such incident.  
HEALTH & SAFETY. The Organisers of the events have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
2. The decision of the Judge is final. Any abuse towards anyone on the Show field will not be tolerated.
3. The Committee reserves the right to limit entries, cancel any event due to unforeseen circumstances, refuse or cancel an entry.
4. Riding hats or helmets to minimum BS EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn in all classes.  
Riding hats or helmets must be worn fastened, at all times whilst mounted.  
For riders safety, footwear with correct heels must be worn at all times when mounted.  
Correct dress to be worn at all times. Competitors will be asked to leave the ring if not correctly attired, Jackets to be worn at all times whilst taking part in all rings and minimus. For safety reasons hairnets must be worn. SSRC recommends that riders wear body protectors to at least BETA class 3 standard.
5. No entry fee will be refunded after the Postal Closing Date, unless a Medical or Veterinary Certificate is produced before the Show/Event commences.
6. Objections must be made in writing to the Organising Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident accompanied by £20 deposit, which will be refunded, if the objection is sustained.
7. Galloping is prohibited outside Arenas.
8. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
9. No fires or barbecues to be lit on the Show Ground.
10. No horse/pony under the age of 4 years may compete in any ridden class. Mares with foals at foot must not be left unattended whilst separated. Foals to be shown must be over 6 weeks old. Stallions may compete but they must be shown bitted and may be asked to leave the ring or showground if they are deemed to cause a nuisance.
11. The age for Juniors to be taken at 1st January 2008.
12. Competitors to be ready for their class 5 minutes before its commencement.
13. Please take your litter home or put it in the bins provided. The showfield is grazed throughout the year and discarded rubbish may kill livestock.
14. **ANYONE CAN ENTER THOSE CLASSES, WHICH INCORPORATE A CHILTERN AND THAMES QUALIFIER. HOWEVER TO BE ELEGIBLE FOR QUALIFICATION FOR THE CHILTERN AND THAMES CHAMPIONSHIPS YOU MUST BECOME A MEMBER IN ADVANCE AND DECLARE MEMBERSHIP NUMBER ON ENTRY TO ANY CLASS.
